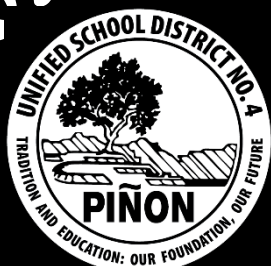

The Annual Navajo Nation Johnson O'Malley Conference will take place on October 29-31, 2019 at Twin Arrows Casino & Resort. All artwork submissions will be on display and power point during the event. The grand prize winner will be featured on the conference booklet.

Eligibility

Kindergarten – 12th grade students. One entry per student.

Entry requirements

Must submit student entry and artwork release form. Artwork size must be 8.5"x11".

Artwork Theme

The theme for the Art Contest is: **"Determined, Resilient and Still Moving Forward"**. We want to see what this topic inspires in you as a student. Artwork can be realistic or abstract.

Media requirements

Any of the following may be used:

- Paint (watercolor, tempera, acrylic, etc.)
- Drawing materials (pencil, charcoal, colored chalk, pastels, oil pastels, colored pencils, markers, etc.)

Students are encouraged to use bold colors.

Judging Criteria

The Pinon USD JOM IEC Members will review artwork submissions based on the following criteria:

- Interpretation of the theme
- Originality
- Art size requirements

Copyright Law

Any artwork that depicts copyrighted images will be rejected. All artwork must be original ideas and created entirely by the student.

Deadline for Entries:

All entries must be postmarked no later than on **Monday, September 23, 2019**. Entries submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

Notification of Winners:

Grand prize winner, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners will be selected on October 2, 2019 during the monthly Johnson O'Malley Planning Committee meeting at 10:00 a.m. and notified shortly thereafter. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

- Grand prize winner will receive an Award Ribbon and Backpack full of art supplies.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will receive Award Ribbons and Art Supplies.
