2. Paul Magnuson, Tse Bit Ai Middle School Principal, presented the Yearbook Ad sale to help pay for Yearbook.

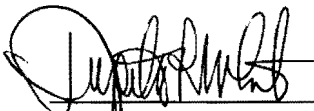
C. Pandora Mike, Director of Curriculum, Instruction, and Staff Development presented the Course Sequence Proposal for CCSD Social Studies. Teachers met and implemented the Course Sequence Proposal.

- D. Cynthia Theodore, Transportation Program Specialist, presented and explained each location of the Per Capita Feeder Routes for reimbursement to parents for students with no bus routes in area or medical condition with special needs.
- E. Mamie Becenti, Naschitti Elementary School Principal, presented the School Improvement Grant Quarterly Update for Naschitti. Areas of strategies: Teachers and Leadership Effectiveness, Structure Strategies, Interventionist, Dine Language Coach, School Base Clinic, Provide Parent Education and Family Learning, developing Parent Resource Center, Support to the Building Principals, working with the budget in all areas, Recruitment and Retention, Data Collection and Analysis, non-academic support for students attendance, supplies and material, after school tutoring, and AYP requirement.
