

Scholarships

for SJC Teacher Education students



The San Juan College Financial Aid office is open Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. in the clocktower. Financial Aid staff can help you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Below are six scholarships **Teacher Education students** may qualify for at San Juan College:

1 Grow Your Own Teachers (GYOT)

Must have worked in a school for two years and obtain letter from school principal. Minimum 2.5 GPA is required. Complete FAFSA, then contact Financial Aid.

2 Teacher Preparation Affordability Scholarship (TPAS)

Education majors qualify with 2.5 GPA, enrolled in 6 hours. Alternative Licensure Program (ALP) students qualify enrolled in 5 hours. Complete FAFSA, then contact Financial Aid.

3 BWP Legacy Scholarship

One-time \$500 scholarship for any teacher in training, minimum 3.0 GPA. This is a Fall semester awarded scholarship only and licensed teachers do not qualify (Gifted or TESOL). Contact Alexis Esslinger - esslingera@sanjuancollege.edu for details.

4 Opportunity Scholarship

All New Mexicans may qualify for tuition-free higher education with 2.5 GPA enrolled in 6 or more credit hours. Contact Financial Aid.

5 New Mexico Early Childhood Scholarship (ECECD)

Processed through the state of New Mexico, ECED majors qualify if they are working more than 20 hours per week at a child care site. FAFSA not required. Go to: nmeccd.org/scholarships

6 ECECD Student Success Scholarship

\$1,500 or \$2,000 financial award for flexible support to meet the needs of Early Childhood Education students who must be enrolled either part or full-time, have a 2.5 g.p.a and need to contact Financial Aid. A letter of request, graduation timeline and reference will be required for funding.

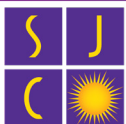
