TalkSpace (www.talkspace.com) credentialed professionals treat a variety of issues, including couples & teens, subscription rates and plans are available, with EAP and insurance coverage.

BetterHelp (<u>www.betterhelp.com</u>) credentialed professionals are matched to your individual needs, within individual, couples and family counseling, utilizing video conferencing, chatting live, etc., costs range from \$40 - \$70 per week, with financial assistance available.

Online-Therapy.com CBT-based services covering multiple BH disorders and diagnoses, with prices ranging from \$32-\$64 per week. They don't accept insurance.

Amwell.com covers both physical and psychological health, visits available 24/7, credientialled and licensed medical and BH staff, insurance coverage, with the cost of a psychologist or counselor varying from \$99-\$110.

MDLive.com a comprehensive telemedicine platform with a division specially for psychiatry services, offering both counseling and prescription services. Services are offered via video, phone or app, as well as insurance coverage.

7 Cups (<u>www.7cups.com</u>) affordable online therapy, free 24/7 emotional support & chat rooms. Subscription options. Generally, services are not covered by insurance.

Teen Counseling (<a href="www.teencounseling.com">www.teencounseling.com</a>) an online platform for teens aged 13-19, with live chats, phone calls, video conferencing & messaging with a "private" counseling room with a licensed therapist. Parent do not have access to this room, although therapists must report dangers. Costs range from \$40-\$70 per week.

Pride Counseling (<u>www.pridecounseling.com</u>) LGBTQ+ centered counseling, costs range from \$40-\$70 per week. Services usually not covered by insurance.

Doctor on Demand (<u>www.doctorondemand.com</u>) services offered with or without a subscription plan, within both medical or behavioral health, sessions run from \$129-\$179 for psychology consultation and accepts insurance.
